

Articles of incorporation of the Sunapee Lake Spiritualist Campmeeting Association, made and entered into the 17th day of August, A.D. 1893.

We the subscribers hereto, being of lawful age, do hereby associate ourselves together and agree to form a body corporate, by the name, for the objects and purposes, and by the means and methods set forth in the following.

Articles of Agreement.

Article 1. The corporate name of said Association shall be,

The Sunapee Lake Spiritualist Campmeeting Association.

Art. 2. The objects and purposes of said Association shall be, by the holding of Campmeetings, the employment of preachers, lecturers and instructors, to teach propagate promulgate and disseminate, the views, doctrines and tenets, of the religious sect known as Spiritualists, as well as our own personal instruction and edification in those views, doctrines and tenets.

Art. 3. The said corporation shall be located and its business principally transacted in the town of Newbury in the county of Merrimack and State of New-Hampshire; but any business not local in its nature may be transacted in any other place according as circumstances may require.

Art. 4. The Officers of said corporation shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and a Business Committee to consist of three members.

Art. 5. The President, when present, shall preside in all meetings of the Association. In case of the absence or disability of the President at any meeting the Vice-President shall preside.

Art. 6. The Secretary shall keep and preserve true and faithful records of all meetings and transactions of the association and shall have charge of its correspondence.

Art. 7. The Treasurer shall be the depository and custodian of all funds of the Association and pay them out on orders drawn by the Business Committee.

All contracts and agreements of the corporation shall be made by the Business Committee, who are authorized to affix the corporate seal to all its contracts necessary to be made in writing.

Art. 8. The Annual Meeting of the Association shall be a Campmeeting, held at the place known as Bloodgett's Landing in the said town of Newbury, to be commenced on the last Sunday in July of each year, and to continue as long as the Association shall determine, and any corporate business may be transacted at any time during any such Annual Meeting.

Special meetings of the Association may be called by the President or in case of his absence or disability by the Vice President, notice thereof being given by publication in some newspaper printed in said county of Merrimack three weeks in succession, the last publication to be one week at least before the time appointed for such meeting. And the President, and in case of his absence or disability the Vice President shall call such meeting with like notice, on the written request of the Business

Committee or of any five members.

The Association, for the purposes of its Annual Campmeeting, may take and hold a lease of such tract of land, for such term of time not to exceed ten years in any one term, and at such annual rent, as it may determine, by itself or the Business Committee.

Art. 9. Any person may become a member of the Association by subscribing his or her name to these Articles of Agreement and paying to the Treasurer the sum of one dollar for the use of the Association.

The yearly dues shall be one dollar to be paid by each member at the Annual Campmeeting to the Treasurer for the use of the Association; and on neglect of any member to make such payment for two years in succession his or her membership shall cease, unless excused by vote of the Association.

Art. 10. For insubordination, or conduct unbecoming the Christian character, a member may, after due trial, be reprimanded, suspended or expelled from membership.

Art. 11. All funds of the Association aside from the membership fees and annual dues, shall be raised by voluntary subscription and not otherwise.

Art. 12. These articles may be altered or amended at any Annual Meeting of the Association by a majority vote of the members present and voting.
